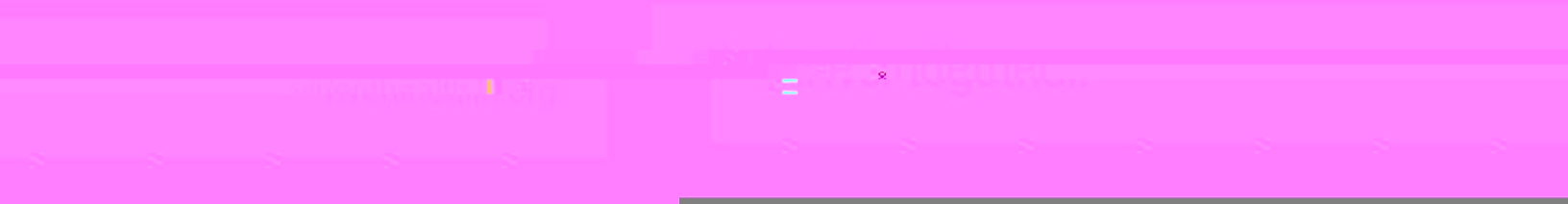

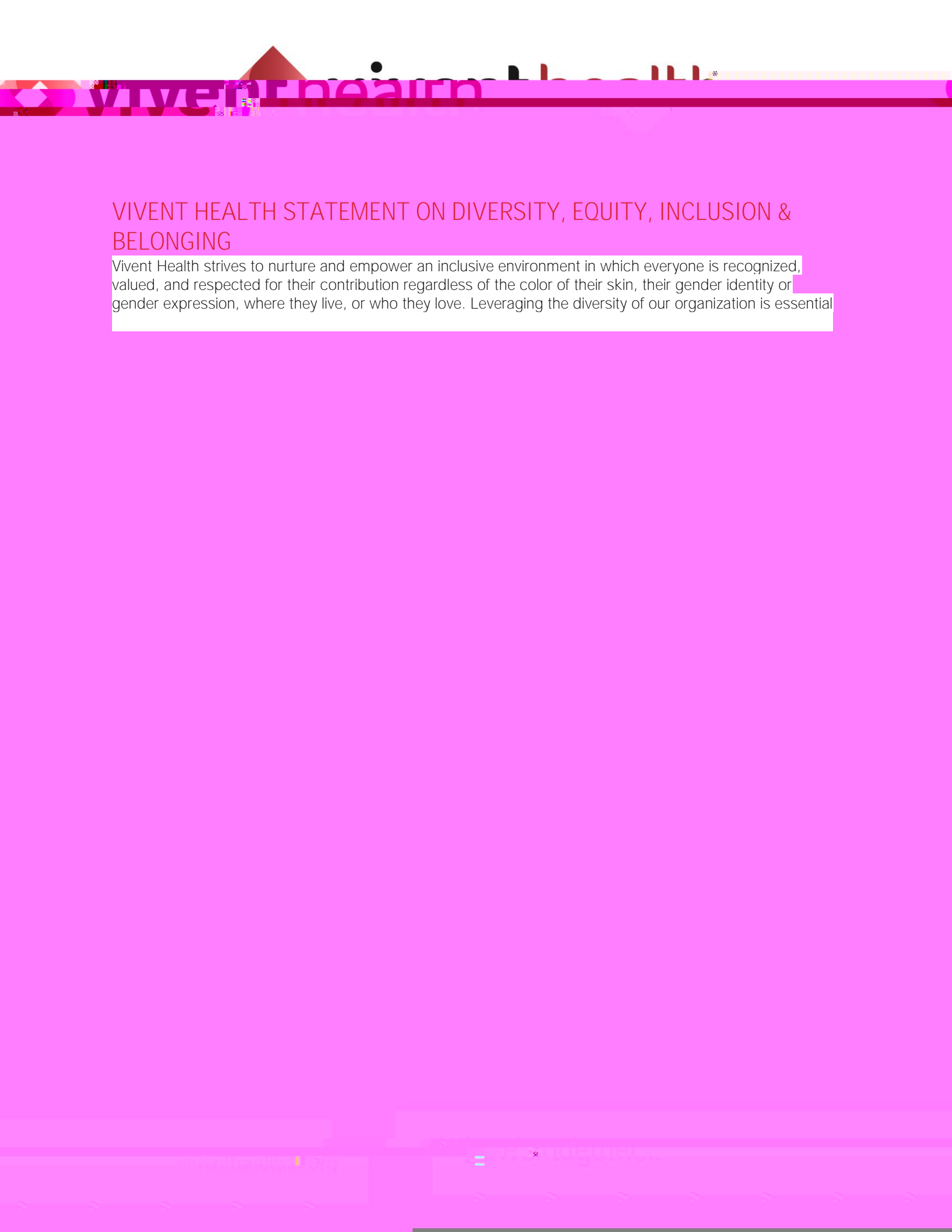

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Applicants must be a PharmD graduate of an accredited college of pharmacy and be participating in or have completed an ASHP-accredited PGY1 pharmacy residency program or one in the ASHP accreditation process (candidate or preliminary accreditation status), unless otherwise approved by ASHP as a PGY2 residency application candidate. Applicants must be eligible for licensure in Wisconsin. The application deadline is January 5th, 2024 and all materials must be received by that date to ensure the application is considered. Applications should be submitted electronically through ASHP PhORCAS.

No person at Vivent Health will solicit or accept any ranking-related information from any applicant.

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS INCLUDE

1. Letter of intent, not to exceed one single-spaced page, highlighting your strengths as a candidate as well as your interest in Vivent Health. Please follow these instructions while writing your letter of intent:
 - i. Formal heading with addresses is not needed
 - ii. Letter should be addressed to Members of the Residency Advisory Committee

2. Curriculum Vitae
3. Three letters of reference using the PhORCAS Standardized Reference Template
4. Official college of pharmacy transcript

Each residency candidate is responsible for properly completing the online application, sending fees to PhORCAS on time, and regularly checking the status of their file online by logging onto PhORCAS web application. The Residency Advisory Committee reserves the right to review each application on a case-by-case basis.

INTERVIEW FORMAT

Vivent Health will be conducting residency interviews in a virtual format for 2024. Candidates will have an opportunity for an optional site tour.

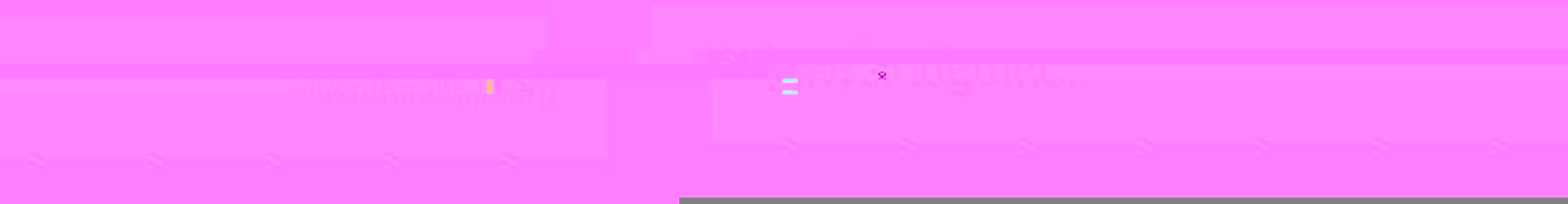
